- 1. Review of Previous Minutes from April 5, 2010: Minor corrections and adjustments were made to the minutes. The adjusted minutes were approved by consensus.
- 2. North Valley Reporter: The April issue of the North Valley Reporter was distributed by various people. Sarah intended to pick up May issues of the Reporter to distribute at the meeting, but they were not yet available.
- **3. T-Shirts:** Sarah has found that the T-shirts cost more than originally expected more than the \$400 that was approved by the Council. Sarah will pick up the extra cost and may be reimbursed later. Sarah only received a few responses to her e-mail requesting sizes.
- 4. Making Contacts: Sarah continued her previous discussion about distributing the Reporter. She included an instructional handout about key points to remember. - **5. Information Table:** Sarah discussed strategies for the information table. Highly important is understanding of our geography so we can determine if someone is in our Council area. It is also important that we complete information for people to assure that it is legible. The official sign-up sheets for the Table will be at the next Council meeting, but Sarah intends to start recruiting earlier.
