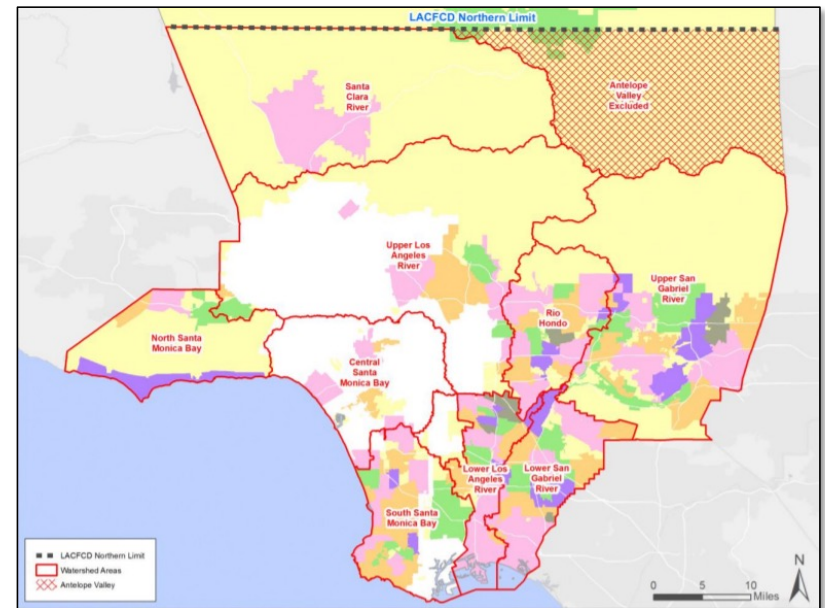

Safe Clean Water Program

- LA County voters passed Measure W in 2018 to establish the Safe Clean Water Program.
- The program generates approximately \$285 million annually for multi-benefit projects that will improve water quality and capture stormwater.
- Program includes funding for municipalities and a regional competitive grant program for LA County's nine watersheds.



Safe Clean Water Program

Water Quality Compliance

- Protect water quality
- Protect rivers, lakes, and bays
- Assist in compliance with federal, state, and local water quality mandates



Water Supply & Resilience

- Reduce LA's reliance on imported water
- Develop new water supplies



Community Investments

- Invest in disadvantaged communities
- Create more green space
- Environmental justice
- Flood protection
- Create jobs for local workforce

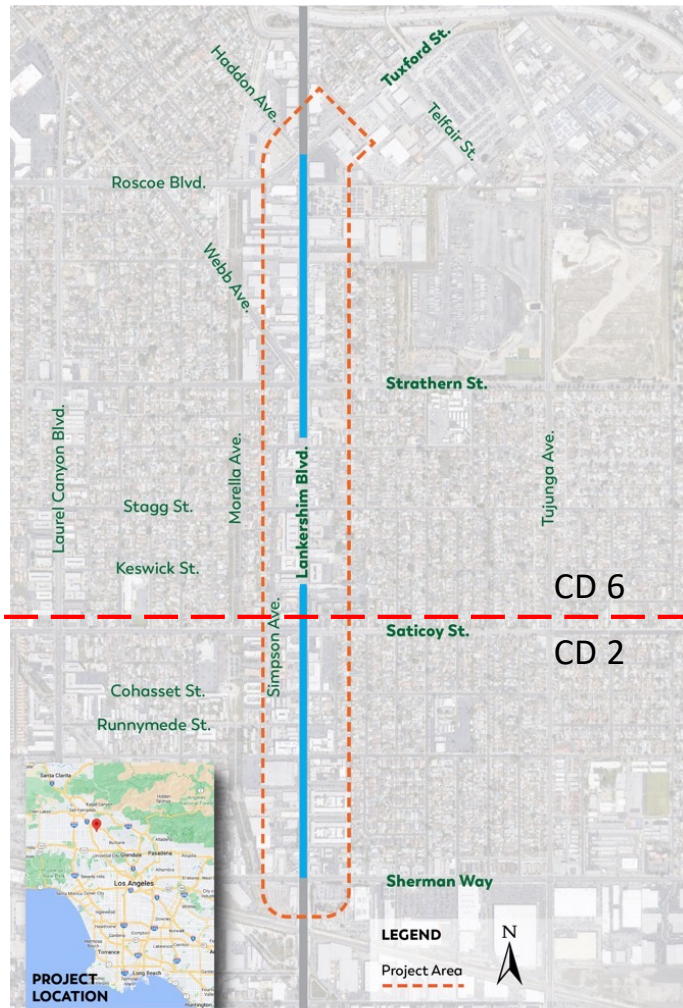


Alleviate flooding by capturing stormwater

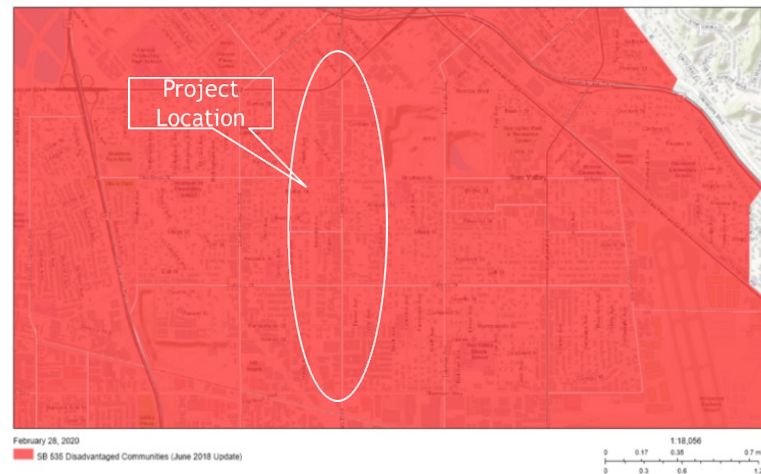


Project Location



- Lankershim Boulevard from Sherman Way to Tuxford Street
- Communities of North Hollywood and Sun Valley
- Los Angeles City Council Districts 2 and 6
- North Hollywood Northeast Neighborhood Council
- Sun Valley Area Neighborhood Council
- Area is rated as a Disadvantage Community (DAC)

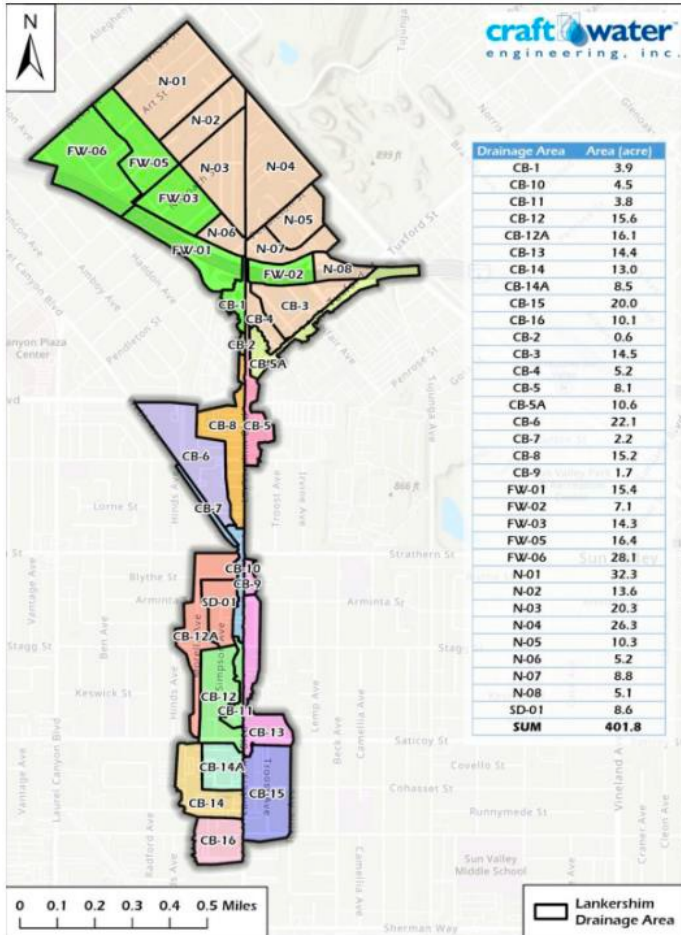
SB 535 Disadvantage Communities Map



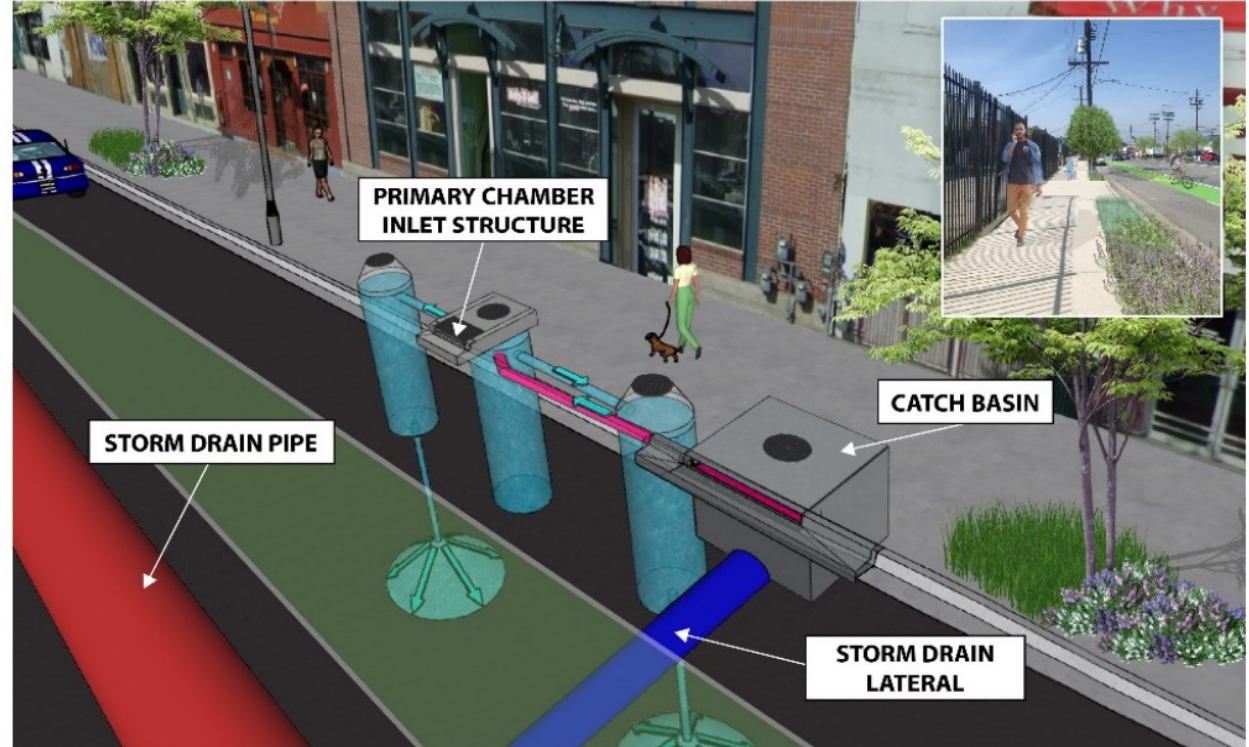
Project Scope

- Capture and infiltrate the stormwater from an 85th percentile storm
- Install catch basins and storm drain along Lankershim Boulevard, in phases
- Install green infrastructure – dry wells, trees, planters
- Improve sidewalks, curb and gutter
- Plant trees and shrubs from Tuxford Street to Sherman Way

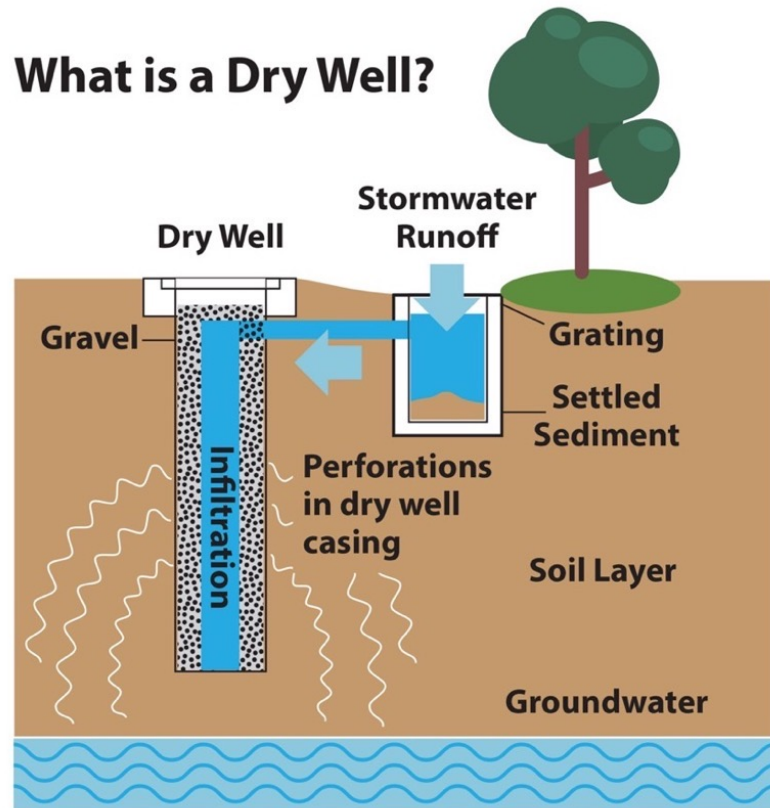
Project Details - Stormwater Infrastructure



- Capture and Infiltrate 102 Acre-Feet/Year
- 110 New Drywells (85th percentile storm)
- 33 New Catch Basins
- New 72-inch Stormwater Discharge Pipe (10-year storm)

- New trees planted along Lankershim Blvd. between Sherman Way and Tuxford Street



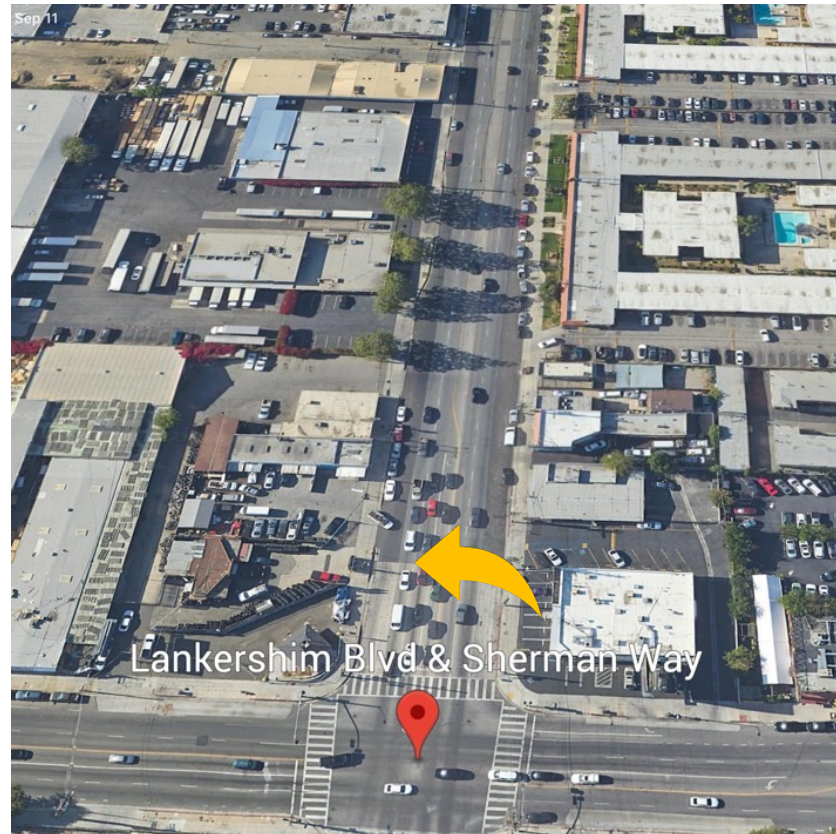
Project Details – Sidewalks and Curb and Gutters
