On August 29, 2023 the City Council had a motion referred to the Housing & Homelessness Committee & Transportation Committee (<u>CF 23-0914</u>). The North Hollywood North East Neighborhood Council (NHNENC) fully supports the motion.

We especially support that "the City should leverage every public asset within its jurisdiction, leaving no stone unturned. This includes our public rights of way, where a program, with proper restrictions, could provide centralized locations for RVs to park and access services." Our understanding is that a Public Right of Way is typically a strip of land 50 to 60 feet wide that contains the public street, sidewalks, and utilities. We support finding locations that are outside of our residential areas, commercial corridors and other sensitive uses spaces.

The NHNENC respectfully requests that CalTrans Park n Ride lots that are not being utilized in the community also be considered given their locations within Los Angeles's jurisdiction. For example: Council District 2 (CD2) includes a Park n Ride on Oxnard Blvd near the 170 in North Hollywood. There rarely are vehicles in the lot that are not already Vehicle Dwellings or RV Dwellings. Given their locations, we believe that utilizing these types of Public Assets would be a good match for these purposes.
